STUDENTS IN ACTION

RBTCT students went into action in October with their outreach before semester break, taking the Good News of Jesus to the lost and needy.

During 5 days of street witnessing and evangelism services 210 people were saved, and 1 was baptized in the Holy Spirit, and 48 healed.

The students ministered to a Muslim man while witnessing in the neighborhood. It came as no surprise that he was not openly receptive to what the students shared about Jesus the Savior and the Healer, but he let the students talk to him anyway. What the students did not know was that this man had pain in his shoulder. The following day he planned to go see the doctor because his shoulder hurt so much, but before doing so he remembered what the students told him about Jesus the Healer. So he attended the evening service first to see if Jesus is real. At the end of the service, he followed the instructions to lay hands on himself and pray. When he did so, his shoulder pain immediately left. He went from resistive to receptive, and prayed to accept Jesus.

Another woman suffering from Parkinson's disease for 12 years could no longer walk or even take care of herself. Her daughter took care of her mother's daily needs. After the woman prayed to receive salvation, the students also prayed for her to be healed. Immediately, she sat upright, then stood up, and began walking around for quite some time, and her speech immediately became clearer too. *(Continue in the lower right column)*

BEWARE MISSIONARY EMERGENCY SCAM

The sophistication of technology is used for both noble purposes and fraud. We want you to be aware that the names and email addresses of some ministers and missionaries have been used to defraud compassionate friends and individuals. A friend and fellow minister of ours recently experienced this.

The fraudulent email comes in the form of an emergency email from a person you know claiming a crisis, being stranded, arrested, or in desperation in the country of their ministry, nearby, or elsewhere, and asking for emergency financial help to be sent outside the usual means, such as Western Union, bank transfer to a specific account, etc. Keith and Sharon do not respond to emergencies in this manner. If you receive such an email "from us", please contact our US office immediately. NTNI handles all contributions for us, and this would be true in the event of an emergency as well.

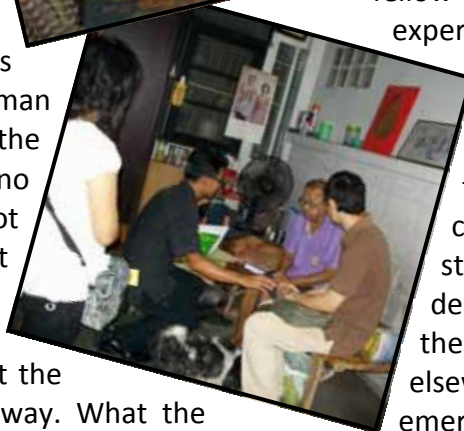

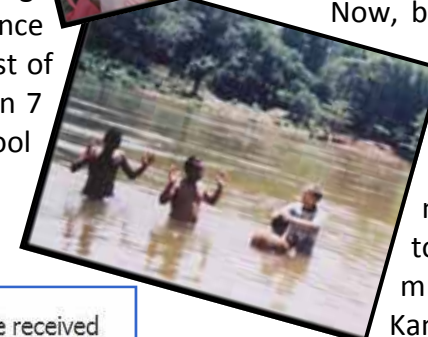
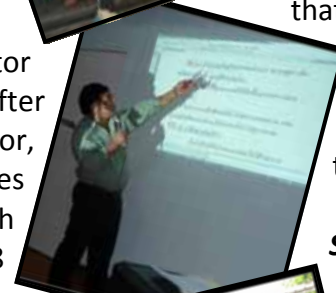
BROTHERLY LOVE FELLOWSHIP
