Dear Partners,

It is hard to believe that as of this November 2011, I have been living for 24 years in Aklan, but traveling to other parts of the country. I have seen the hunger and longing of the Filipinos for answers that only Jesus Christ can bring them. Since the beginning of 2011 we had been busy with our Bible school activities. Our six second year students went to different churches ministering to the children, youth and with women. Vivian Francisco, one of the teacher in Bible School and pastoring in Camaligan, Batan, Aklan, together with Sis Glenda Delos Santos were chosen to teach more about the Holy Spirit. After the teaching, a lot of teens were revived and baptized with the Holy Spirit as they spoke in different tongues tears rolled down their face, asking for more of God’s presence and committing all of them in Christ Jesus. I pray that the contagious power of love for the Lord Jesus Christ among youths in Aklan will spread throughout the province and to all parts of the Philippines.
